



Patient's Confidentiality Protections from Carolina Collaborative Community Care (4C)

Confidentiality of Patient Information:

- 1. Access to confidential patient information is limited to staff members with a need to know based on their job function.
- 2. Any patient information that is released outside of HIPAA guidelines requires the patient's authorization.
- 3. All staff members are required to pledge their confidentiality on an annual basis.
- 4. All staff members are required to attend annual trainings on HIPAA and Confidentiality.
- 5. All patient confidential information is stored on secured servers hosted by 4C and Community Care of North Carolina.
- 6. All patient confidential information is the property of the Division of Medical Assistance (DMA) as the covered entity.
- 7. Patients have the right to request a record of releases of their confidential information.
